Brings Legendary Art Dealer Ronald Feldman for
Contemporary Talks

Atlanta—November 15, 2010 –The Atlanta Contemporary Art Center (ACAC) brings legendary art dealer Ronald Feldman of Ronald Feldman Fine Arts to Atlanta as part of ACAC's new Contemporary Talks lecture series on Thursday, November 18, from 7 – 8 p.m.

Ronald Feldman and ACAC Artistic Director Stuart Horodner will discuss Feldman's 40-year career as a champion of feminist, political, conceptual and performative practices, and how he helped make these challenging modes of working commercially viable.

Ronald Feldman Fine Arts was founded in 1971 by Ronald and Frayda Feldman, and since that time the gallery artists have participated in more than 2000 national and international exhibitions. Artists who have worked with the gallery include Ida Applebroog, Eleanor Antin, Joseph Beuys, Chris Burden, Komar & Melamid, Leon Golub, Andy Warhol, Hannah Wilke and others. In 1993, Feldman was appointed by President Clinton to the National Council on the Arts, where he served for five years. His board affiliations include Creative Capital, People for the American Way, Exit Art, the Research Center for Arts and Culture at Columbia University and the Art Dealers Association of America.

The Ronald Feldman talk will take place in the Hill Auditorium of the High Museum of Art, 1280 Peachtree St, Atlanta, 30309. This program is free; however, seating is limited and must be reserved. Tickets are available through the Woodruff Arts Center Box Office at 404.733.5000.
